

PIKE HEAD AXE

The PIKE HEAD AXE is a heavy duty combination axe head with pointed pike spear and is most commonly known as a "Ships Axe", where traditionally, the axe head is used to sever cable and the pike end is used for penetration of locked steel shipboard bulkhead doors to gain rescue entry or emergency egress. Manufactured in Western Australia, both large and small PIKE HEAD AXES are cast in high grade steel with a finished blade edge and fitted with a straight grain timber handle. These combination hand tools have been designed as very adaptable, rugged use emergency rescue tools which are essential to standby Rescue Trailers, aerial rescue fixed wing aircraft and helicopters, Marine Fire and Rescue as well as Fire Brigade Crews.
